# OpenAlex

## What is OpenAlex?

OpenAlex is a fully open and comprehensive bibliographic database that aligns perfectly with the principles of Open Science. In simple terms, it is a massive, free index of the global research ecosystem. Its mission is to create a fully open and interconnected map of scholarly communication. Unlike Web of Science or Scopus, OpenAlex allows its information to be consulted and downloaded without a subscription. Its technical infrastructure and data models are publicly documented, fostering transparency and the development of new tools.

## Coverage & Scale

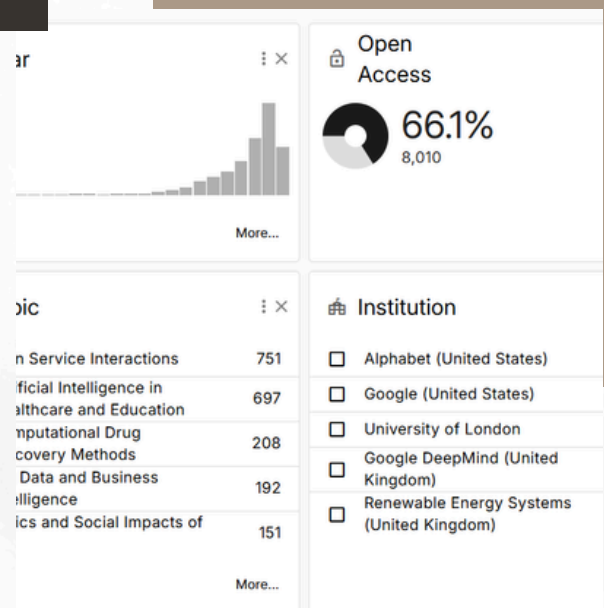
OpenAlex has 271.3 million indexed works, with an additional expansion pack containing another 192 million records with lower-quality metadata sourced from DataCite and institutional repositories. OpenAlex ended 2025 with 1.5 billion monthly API calls across OpenAlex and Unpaywall combined, exceeding Crossref for the first time. Over 1,100 research outputs in 2025 referenced OpenAlex.

## Key Entities in OpenAlex

OpenAlex uses nine types of entities: works, authors, sources, institutions, topics, keywords, publishers, funders, and geo. Works are individual academic publications such as articles, books, datasets, or reports. Each work includes information about the title, authors, source and publication date, as well as citation relationships with other works.



Backed by a \$3.6M Wellcome grant, awards are now first-class objects in OpenAlex. Grants from 30+ funders worldwide have been ingested, including NIH, NSF, DOE, UKRI, Wellcome, ERC, DFG, SNSF, NSERC, CIHR, KAKEN/JSPS, ARC, FAPESP, Gates, NWO, and more.

# Discover, Explore & Analyse Research Freely and Openly

## Why Should Use OpenAlex?

It helps you find research papers freely without needing library database access. You can discover papers on your topic, explore related works, and identify key authors in your field all for free.

OpenAlex gives a broader, more inclusive search experience. Its wide coverage helps you uncover conference papers, preprints from servers like arXiv, and publications from newer open-access journals that might not yet be indexed in traditional databases. It is especially useful for literature reviews and systematic reviews.

Citation information for a much broader universe of documents than offered by commercial databases makes OpenAlex prominent in research evaluation, as recognised in the Barcelona Declaration. You can use it to track citations, analyse research trends, monitor open access compliance, and evaluate journal impact all without a subscription.

Institution and Geo filters narrow results by university or country. Open Access shows only freely available papers. Citation and IDs filters help locate specific or highly cited works. Combining multiple filters together gives you highly precise, targeted search results effortlessly.

## **ISSN Portal**

Did you know that the ISSN Portal ([portal.issn.org](http://portal.issn.org)) can help you verify the authenticity of a journal. When you search for any journal on the ISSN Portal, it not only confirms whether the ISSN is officially registered, but also provides a direct link to the journal's officially registered homepage. You can simply compare this link with the journal website you received a submission invitation from. If the URLs do not match, the journal could be fake, hijacked, or predatory. Make this your first and quickest check before submitting your valuable research manuscript anywhere!

## Global Library News



### EBSCO Launches AgeLine with Full Text

EBSCO Information Services has introduced AgeLine with Full Text, a comprehensive research database focused on adults aged 50 and over, covering social, psychological, economic, and health aspects of aging. It features over 100 journals on topics like caregiving, retirement, health policy, and elder law. Designed for researchers, students, and educators, it supports disciplines such as gerontology, public health, and social work. The database aims to help libraries provide dedicated access to social gerontology literature, informing academic study, policy, and evidence-based practice.

### LibraryOne Launches as Independent Digital Library Company

LibraryOne has officially launched as an independent digital library services company after acquiring key platform assets formerly operated by Baker & Taylor. Its portfolio including Boundless, TitleSource360, Content Café, ePopUp Library, and CollectConnect supports libraries in digital lending, collection development, metadata enrichment, and analytics. Founded by technology entrepreneurs Hari Katukota and Manjunath Ratakonda, the company maintained all platforms without a single day of downtime since acquiring the assets in December 2025. Major publishers have agreed to partner with LibraryOne, with audiobook ordering already resumed.

### Taylor & Francis and DataSeer Extend AI Partnership

Taylor & Francis and DataSeer have extended their development partnership, using DataSeer's SnapShot AI service to help authors comply with journal data-sharing requirements. The tool assesses whether authors have generated new data or reused existing datasets, and checks compliance with journal-specific data policies. The next phase focuses on refining SnapShot for live manuscript submission and supporting editorial teams in conducting data checks quickly and at scale. The collaboration also aims to generate structured reasoning summaries and provide policy-aligned author communication templates to improve research transparency and integrity.

### ASME Partners with Wiley for Publishing Operations

The American Society of Mechanical Engineers (ASME) has entered into an agreement with Wiley, under which Wiley will manage sales, marketing, and operations for ASME's journals, conference proceedings, and digital collections. ASME retains copyright and full editorial governance, including peer review authority. Wiley assumes ASME's contractual relationships with libraries and universities worldwide to ensure service continuity. ASME publishes over 2,000 papers annually across 35+ journals. The partnership aims to expand the global reach and long-term sustainability of ASME's publishing program while keeping engineering knowledge accessible worldwide.

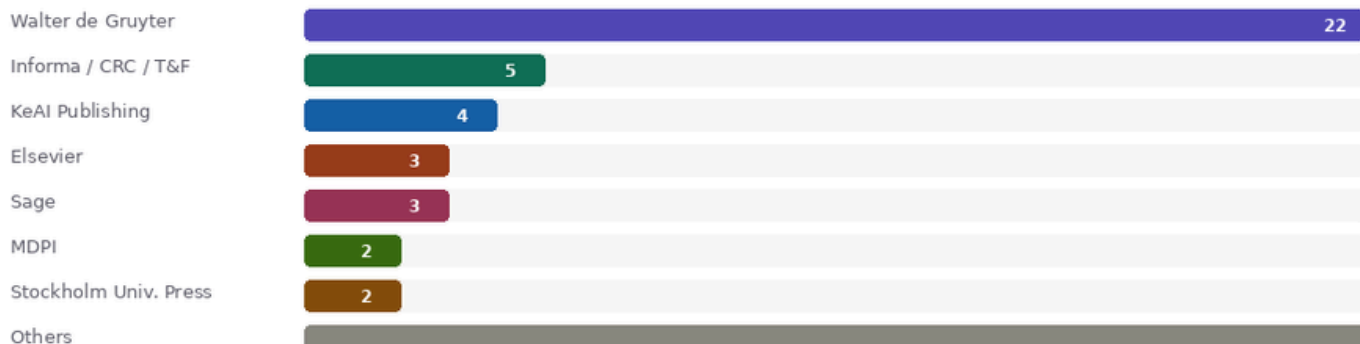
